When Overnight Delivery Isn't Fast Enough

Domestic Same Day, Next Flight Out, Service

Sometimes, delivery on the next business day just isn't fast enough. When you need critical shipments to arrive within hours, you can call the SDS Worldwide Logistics team for help. Weight-loss and the Workplace — SDS Winds Down First Ever Slimdown

Studies show that weight gain in the United States is a serious problem, in terms of productivity, 58 million days of work are lost in relation to excess weight amounting to \$5.7 billion, annually (Business and Health). Recently, this trend has received a great deal of attention, and some workplaces are taking proactive steps to buck the trend.

SDS and its employees recently did their part by creating a program to promote better health. It began in February with the First Annual Great SDS Slimdown. The friendly competition encouraged employees to pare down the pounds and offered a prize for the employee who lost the greatest percentage of body weight during a three month period. A good number of employees participated in the voluntary competition, and by the time the competition was over, net weight losers outnumbered weight gainers by almost 2 to 1. Many of those who gained weight during that period stated that they would have likely gained more weight if they were not making a conscious effort to pay attention to their diet and exercise.

In the end, Robert Ruiz of the Local/Tri-State Operations Team won the contest by shedding over 4.5% of his body weight. Congratulations to Robert and to all the successful participants.

Post Office Seeks 3-cent Stamp Rate Hike

“Forever” Stamp Proposed with Operational Rate Hike



The independent Postal Rate Commission is proposing a “forever” stamp for letters, good no matter how much postal rates increase. If approved, the change would take effect May 2007.

The Rate Commission has proposed raising the price of a stamp for a letter by 3 cents, to 42 cents. If the increase takes effect, the forever stamp would be available for 42 cents. If the First-Class rate rises at anytime; to any amount, the 42 cent forever stamp would still be honored on letters. Once the new price takes effect, forever stamps would then sell for the new rate. The forever stamp is part of a broader rate adjustment plan to cover operations costs.

The January 2006 rate increase was instituted to fund a \$3.1 billion escrow account required by a 2003 federal law. Public Law 108-18 transferred to the USPS, the obligation to make payments to the Treasury for the costs of civil service pensions related to military and other government services of postal employees.
